BURBANK – The office of Orthopaedic Surgery Specialists offers state-of-the-art, multidisciplinary, compassionate care for the treatment of injuries, traumas, and disorders of the musculoskeletal system. Drs. Stephan Yacoubian, Raymond Raven III, and Shahan Yacoubian, bring many years of education and experience to their practice and have all served extra fellowships of in-depth training in subspecializations.

Dr. Stephan Yacoubian earned his M.D. at the Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine, followed by orthopedic surgery residency at Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York. Subsequently, he completed a fellowship program at University of Connecticut. He specializes in sports medicine and arthroscopic surgery, a less invasive procedure used to treat joint injuries. Arthroscopic surgery of the knee, shoulder, and other joint injuries may reduce patient recovery time due to a reduced impact on the surrounding tissue and cartilage. And Dr. Stephan Yacoubian gained experience in sports medicine by treating members of the New York Rangers.

Dr. Raven earned his medical education at UC-San Francisco School of Medicine. He completed his orthopedic surgery residence at this institution as well. He subspecialized in hand and upper extremity surgery at St. Lukes Roosevelt Hospital in New York. He treats patients needing hand, elbow, and shoulder surgery, arthritis surgery, adult and child fracture care, work-related injuries, nerve repair, congenital surgery of the arms, and also supervises physical therapy.

Dr. Shahan Yacoubian also earned his M.D. at Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine. He completed his orthopedic surgery training at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York followed by subspecialization in adult reconstructive and joint surgery during his fellowship at Harvard Medical School's Brigham and Women's Hospital. Dr. Shahan Yacoubian treats a variety of joint problems from cartilage degradation to hip replacement surgery and revisions of prior replacements, and uses advanced techniques to treat arthritis.



Drs. Yacoubian and Raven, and staff Hector Alvarez, Nurse Practitioner, also provide general orthopedic services such as treatment of bone fractures, breaks, and traumas, cartilage surgery, and the non-surgical treatments of the back and neck. (Patients requiring spinal surgery are referred to a specialist.) When working with their patients, the doctors exhaust all aspects of treatment, opting for surgery only when it's necessary. And outside the office, they serve as volunteer physicians for the Burbank High School football team.

Orthopaedic Surgery Specialists is located across from Providence Saint Joseph Medical Center on 2625 W. Alameda, Suite 116. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Doctors are on-call for emergencies after hours and on the weekends. Most insurance plans are accepted and financing options are available.
